A distinctive feature of this schistosome is the absence of ciliated warts on the integument, the presence of which constitutes so marked a feature of the African worm. Minor anatomical differences are: (a) smaller size of the worm; (b) its longer vas deferens; (c) the characters of the testes. Male worm with a portion of female. A, Male worm, showing caeca. The female (Fig. 37, B) is almost cylindrical (diameter 0.113 mm.), longer, more slender, and darker than the male. The cervical constriction is quite as marked as in...
