The bill proposes an amendment to the existing copyright statute as follows: Upon the expiration of the copyright of a book, or the renewal thereof, should the same be renewed, there shall exist no superior rights of any nature whatsoever in the publisher or former proprietor thereof to the matter which has been the subject of copyright or to the name or title thereof, but both the matter which has been the subject of copyright and its name or title shall fall into the public domain and thereafter be forever free to the unrestricted use...
