The eastern edge of the bank, or 100-fathom curve, is 10 miles from the islands, with depths between ranging from 10 to 25 fathoms, while the bank to the westward does not extend nearly so far. Bequia Island, the most important and largest of the Grenadines, is 880 feet high, 6f miles in length, in a general northeast and southwest direction, and from 1 to 1 miles wide in the middle, decreasing with an irregular coast line and several bays to a point at both ends. It lies 5 miles southward of St. Vincent, and the same distance northwestward of Baliceaux. The population is about 900. No supplies...
