It arose out of the difficulty experienced in attempting to give a thorough course of qualitative analysis in limited time to large classes of students. The smaller text-books on the subject are too elementary in character to use in connection with such a course; they devote too little attention to the precautions to be observed to insure delicacy of the reactions, to the difficulties encountered by the student in actual work, and to the modifications of the process required in special cases. On the other hand, the manual of Fresenius, though complete and very valuable as a work of reference, is confusing to beginners on account of the complexity of its arrangement and insufficient explanation of the purposes of the various operations. The attempt has been made in the following pages to present an almost equally thorough scheme of qualitative analysis in a more concise and readily intelligible form....
